#### Who Can Submit

Undergraduate students presenting in the 2017 Virginias Collegiate Honors Council Conference are encouraged to submit their posters, presentations, creative works and projects to the VCHC 2017 Conference Proceedings. If the work is co-authored, please make certain you have the co-author's permission to publish the work in this venue.

#### **Benefits to students**

- 1. Provides online open access to your work
- 2. Provides a permanent URL that you can link to in your future academic or job applications
- 3. Showcases and promotes your work through Google and Google Scholar
- 4. Provides long-term archiving and preservation of your work
- 5. You still retain ownership and can re-use as needed

## **How to Submit Your Work**

1. Make sure your work is in an acceptable format. PDF is preferred, but we can accept papers in Microsoft Word or Rich Text Format, Posters and Art Work in image formats (JPG, GIF or PDF), PowerPoint presentations (PPT), and Audio files (MP3). Videos should be uploaded to YouTube or Vimeo with the link provided; we can accept MP4, but download size may be an impediment.

If you use a word-processing program other than Microsoft Word, look for an "export" or "save as" option in your program to save it as an RTF file.

- 2. Submit your work by emailing it to the ODU Digital Commons Manager (digitalcommons@odu.edu). In the email message, please include the following:
- a. Title

- b. Author/s or Artist/s
- c. Date of paper/presentation/art work [e.g. April 8, 2017]
- d. Research Mentors or Advisor(s)
- e. Keywords (words or phrases that will help a user locate your research through a search)
- f. Abstract or Artist Statement

Your submitted abstracted has already been uploaded. Only submit an abstract if you would like to make changes to the one already available online.
